The KATE Distinguished Educator Award was created and designed to recognize outstanding professional educators who have made significant contributions to the educational community in Kentucky--including P-16 teachers, administrators, supervisors, etc. **Nominees do not have to be members of KATE.**

Nominations for this competitive award will be received throughout the year from KATE members in good standing by the Chair of the Selection Committee. **The nomination deadline is May 3, 2010.** The Selection Committee will screen application materials and make a final recommendation to the KATE Board of Directors at the next board meeting--verifying that the award winner has demonstrated:

- extensive experience within the educational community in Kentucky
- significant contribution to teacher preparation program(s) (i.e., cooperating teacher, principal, college/university supervisor or others)
- professional integrity
- involvement in professional organizations

The Distinguished Educator Award will be given at the KATE Annual Fall Conference. The recipient will receive a free one-year membership to KATE and ATE, and an engraved plaque.

KATE DISTINGUISHED EDUCATOR AWARD

Guidelines

Criteria for Selection:

Nominee has demonstrated:

- extensive experience within the educational community in Kentucky 40 pts.
- significant contribution to teacher preparation program(s) (i.e.,
cooperating teacher, principal, college/university supervisor or others) 30 pts.
- professional integrity 10 pts.
- involvement in professional organizations 20 pts.

Nominee shall submit:

- resume
- two letters of recommendation from the professional education community in addition to the letter of recommendation from the recommender on the Nomination Form

Deadline:

Submission of all application information by June 4, 2010, to be considered for presentation at the KATE Annual Fall Conference.

Procedure:

After receiving a nomination, the Chair of the Selection Committee, will contact the nominee to see if the person wants to pursue the award. At that time, the nominee will be asked to submit a resume and two additional references (which address the criteria for selection /performance indicators).
